The 9th International Conference on Low Carbon Asia 2023 hosted in Okayama City



**OKAYAMA, 17<sup>th</sup> October 2023 -** The *9<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Low Carbon Asia* (ICLCA'23) was successfully held in Okayama City, Japan on 17<sup>th</sup> - 19<sup>th</sup> October 2023. The conference was co-organised by Okayama University and Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (UTM). The theme of the conference was *"Sustainable Transitions towards a Resilient & Carbon-Neutral Future"*. A key highlight of the annual conference was the City Mayors Forum that brought together six Mayors from Japan and Malaysia to share their cities' achievements and commitment to taking decarbonisation actions towards carbon neutrality.

The mayoral panellists presented their green initiatives, blueprints and policies implemented in their respective cities. The Mayors Forum session was moderated by Prof Koji Shimada (Ritsumeikan University) and Dr. Junichi Fujino (IGES), Japan. A declaration for sustainable development to be presented at the 2023 UN Climate Change Conference (COP28) meeting was also presented by Dr Junichi Fujino. The Voice of Youth for Sustainable Development was presented by Ms. Kokoru, a student representative from Okayama University.

Another key highlight of ICLCA'23 was the industry showcase session, in which industry sponsors showcased their green technologies with a 3-minute corporate video following the Opening Ceremony and Mayors Forum.

The morning session was graced by two keynote speakers. Prof. Masanobu Abe, Vice President, Okayama University, started off with a presentation on *Regional Zero Carbon Initiatives through the Synergistic Approach of Wooden Architecture, Forestry and Digital Transformation*. Prof. Ho Chin Siong, Universiti Teknologi Malaysia followed with a presentation on *Low Carbon Solutions towards Carbon Neutral Cities in Malaysia*.

Prof Henrik Lund, Editor-in-Chief of Energy, Elsevier then delivered the plenary talk entitled *Resilient* and Fully Decarbonized Smart Renewable Energy System, followed by Emeritus Prof. Zakri Abdul Hamid, Joint Chairman of Malaysian Industry-Government Group for High Technology, who treated the audience with a talk on Science Policy Nexus: The Politics of Climate Change. Other Plenary Speakers were Prof Ahmad Fauzi Ismail (Unversiti Teknologi Malaysia), Prof. Yuichi Moriguchi (NIES), Prof. Sheng Zhou (Shanghai Academy of Agricultural Sciences), Prof. Petar Varbanov, (Brno University of Technology) and Prof. Aristotle Ubando (De La Salle University).

Over 180 papers were selected for oral and poster presentations. During the two-day conference, participants actively exchanged their research findings on various topics that contributed towards shaping smart, resilient and sustainable communities. The joint event was supported by Okayama Convention Hall, IGES, LoCARNet and industry sponsors.

A series of high-impact events were organised, including a special editorial talk on high-impact publication was delivered by Prof Henrik Lund, Editor-in-Chief of Energy, Elsevier. On 19<sup>th</sup> October 2023, the participants joined a field visit to either the Biodiesel Plant in Okayama City or the Maniwa City Biomass Plant.

ICLCA was launched by UTM-Low Carbon Asia Research Centre in 2015; the conference series pledges to make significant progress in implementing the Low Carbon Agenda in fast-growing cities in Asia and beyond. The importance of this conference is clear when cast against the findings of the recently released IPCC Sixth Assessment Report (AR6) Synthesis Report . It is the goal of ICLCA to provide more action-oriented guidance to policymakers, investors, businesses, NGOs, and communities towards mitigating the impacts of economic and social activities on the environment and climate change.

Prior to ICLCA'23 held in Okayama City, past conferences were held in Johor Bahru (2015, 2018 and 2021-online), Kuala Lumpur (2016), Bangkok (2017), Ho Chi Minh City (2019), Shanghai (2020-Online), and Manila (2022-Online). Over the years, the conference series has grown to become an important regional and international platform for Low-Carbon Society knowledge sharing and dissemination, research networking and collaboration, business pairing and investment matching, and institutional and public-private partnership.

ICLCA 2024 is expected to be hosted by Dalian Technology University in Dalian (DUT), China as witnessed by the symbolic ICLCA Flag transfer ceremony from Okayama University to DUT during the closing ceremony.
